



CUSTOMERS OF LODI MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND WATER UTILITY

Lodi Municipal Light and Water Utility has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) to adjust electric rates. The adjustment has been requested in order to cover inflationary increases in operational and maintenance expenses and costs associated with maintaining the reliability of the electric distribution system. In addition, the utility is also requesting approval from the Commission for an amortization expense related to stranded costs from undepreciated meters for an AMI Meter Conversion Project. The last electric rate increase was approved in 2018.

The utility is requesting an overall increase of 5.34%, or \$165,493. The final impact of the rate increase upon individual customers will not be definitely known until the PSC issues an order; however, under the proposed rate structure, based on an average usage of 665 kilowatt-hours (kWh), the typical residential customer's monthly bill would increase from \$82.21 per month to \$86.61 per month, an increase of \$4.40 or 5.4%.

The PSC will conduct a public hearing at locations in Lodi and Madison or by telephone. A notice of the hearing will be published after a date has been set.
