The recycling event is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 20. Please check the city's website for the most current information or call 592-3247.

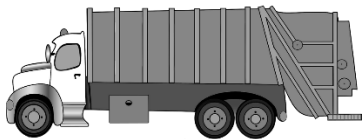

Property Assessment

Each municipality in Wisconsin must hold an Open Book and Board of Review (BOR) session. These sessions allow property owners to review and appeal the assessment of real property and personal property.

The City of Lodi is working with a new Assessor, Milde Appraisal Services, LLC. They will be holding Open Book at City Hall on Wednesday, June 3rd beginning at 3:00 PM. Scheduling details will be posted on the City's website.

If, after the Open Book session, you wish to object to the assessment, you will need to file a written or oral intent to object with the City Clerk a minimum of 48 hours prior to the Board of Review. The Board of Review will meet at Lodi City Hall on Wednesday, June 10th from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

Lottery & Gaming Credit

The Lottery and Gaming Credit is a credit that provides direct relief to qualifying taxpayers on their property tax bills. To qualify for the credit, you must be a Wisconsin resident, own a dwelling and use it as your primary residence, and reside at that property as of the January 1 certification date of the year the property taxes are levied.

Please check your 2019 tax bill to assure you are receiving this credit. Tax bills are available at www.co.columbia.wi.us. If you do not have a Lottery & Gaming credit, you must file an application with the county treasurer. The application can be found at www.revenue.wi.gov/Pages/Form/lottery-home.aspx.
