

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER  
Public Education Requirements Not Met for Lodi Waterworks**

We are required to complete a public education program regarding elevated lead in drinking water on an annual basis. Ninetieth percentile results of lead and copper compliance samples exceeded the lead action level during the most recent compliance period in 2022. The public education material explains the health effects and source of lead in drinking water, and ways to reduce your exposure to lead in drinking water. We did not distribute public education materials.

**What precautions should be taken at this time?**

Let the water run from the tap before using it for drinking or cooking any time the water in a faucet has gone unused for more than 6 hours. Do not cook with, or drink water from the hot water tap

**What was the cause of the missed public education requirements?**

We have been providing public notice of the action level exceedance in our monthly bills, but misunderstood that public education materials needed to be delivered every year. Once notified of our error, we included the materials with the next bill.

**What is being done to correct the problem?**

Public education materials were included with our January 4, 2024 bill, posted at City Hall, the Library, and hand delivered to other public places, all prior to January 17, 2024. The previously mailed letter informing the public of noncompliance did not include all required information, therefor we are now sending this letter.

**When will the problem be resolved?**

Public education materials were included with our January 4, 2024 bill. Notification of noncompliance is resolved by this letter.
